Frequency and venue: once per year, mainly in Lugano, but also in North America and Asia


Strong international character: participants from all 5 continents




27 exhibitors are presenting their face, body, foot, hand scanning systems and software solutions The major technologies are represented: white-light scanning, RGB-D sensor scanning,




